Recently it has been announced that our central postal station is among the list of potential closures by the United States Postal Service. In conjunction with this we are a county seat and the county and all of its ancillary service businesses use the central station for all of there postal needs. It is located within convenient walking distance and allows for quick access when time is greatly limited for the offices, business men and women, and downtown community. The main branch of the post office in Washington not as easily accessed as this location for any type of postal service needs. It is also being used by the whole community and it is always difficult to do business in the every growing limited time that a business customer may have available to them.
